PROPOSED ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM BOARD CREATING RULES RELATING TO DISTRICT REPORTING OF POSTSECONDARY STUDENT PARTICIPATION UNDER COMPULSORY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE, POSTSECONDARY ENROLLMENT OPTIONS, AND TECHNICAL PREPARATION PROGRAMS

(Clearinghouse Rule 95-032)

1	The Wisconsin Technical College System Board proposes an order to create ch. TCS 9,
2	Wis. Admin. Code, relating to district reporting of attendance and other participation in
3	technical college courses or programs by secondary school students under the Wisconsin
4	statutory provisions relating to compulsory school attendance, postsecondary enrollment
5	options, and technical preparation programs.
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8	ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM BOARD
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10	Statutory Authority: ss. 38.04(11)(a) 2 and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.
11	Statute Interpreted: s. 38.04(11)(a) 2, Stats.
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13	1993 Wisconsin Acts 16 and 223, directed the Technical College System Board and
14	the Department of Public Instruction to promulgate rules applicable to technical college district
15	boards and school boards, respectively, which establish a uniform format for reporting the
16	number of secondary school students attending the technical colleges under ss. 118.15(1)(b),

1	(cm), (d) and 118.37, Stats., and the number of students participating in technical preparation
2	programs under s. 118.34, Stats., including the number of courses taken for advanced standing
3	in an associate degree program or other technical college credit.
4	This order creates ch. TCS 9, Wis. Admin. Code, to establish a format for technical
5	college district reporting of secondary school student participation in technical college courses
6	or programs under the categories of compulsory school attendance, postsecondary enrollment
7	options, and technical preparation, as the areas identified by statute.
8	Pursuant to s. 38.04(11)(a)2, Stats., which codifies 1993 Wisconsin Acts 16 and 223, the
9	format developed for district reporting of students in the above-referenced categories is
10	identical to the format established by the Department of Public Instruction.
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12	SECTION 1. Ch. TCS 9 is created to read:

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18	TCS 9.01 PURPOSE. This chapter establishes standards and procedures pursuant to s.
19	38.04(11)(a)2, Stats., for districts to report the number of students participating in district
20	courses under the compulsory education provisions of ss. 118.15(1)(b), (cm) and (d), and

the number of students participating in the postsecondary enrollment options program under the provisions of s. 118.37, Stats., and the number of students participating in technical preparation programs under s. 118.34, Stats., including the number of courses taken for advanced standing in a technical college district's associate degree or vocational diploma program and for postsecondary credit.

TCS 9.02 DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: (1) "Advanced standing" means postsecondary credit granted upon technical college enrollment toward a degree or diploma program for a secondary course taken by a pupil which is part of a sequence of courses designed to help high school graduates make the transition from high school to postsecondary technical education and for which there is an articulation agreement between the school district offering the course and the technical college district.

(2) "Articulation agreement" means an agreement between the school district offering a secondary course and a technical college district through which postsecondary credit may be applied toward advanced standing.

(3) "Board" means the Wisconsin technical college system board.

(4) "Compulsory school attendance participation" means the participation of high school age students in technical college courses or programs under the provisions of s. 118.15 (1)(b), (cm) and (d), Stats.

1	(5) "District" means a technical college district established under ch. 38, Stats.
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3	(6) "District board" means the district board charged with governance of the technical
4	colleges within a district.
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6	(7) "Postsecondary enrollment options program" means enrollment under the
7	provisions of s. 118.37, Stats.
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9	(8) "School district" has the meaning given in s. 115.001(3), Stats.
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11	(9) "Technical preparation program" means a high school program established under
12	s. 118.34, Stats.
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14	(10) "Transcripted credit" means credit that may be applied toward high school
15	graduation requirements or toward a technical college associate degree or vocational diploma
16	program.
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18	9.03 REPORTING OF STUDENTS. (1) Annually, by June 15, technical college districts
19	shall compile a report for the board containing the data elements of sub. (2) to report

(1) shall include the following information regarding 13 students and courses completed for the previous school year: 14 (a) The student's social security number or other unique identifiable number. (b) The student's name. 15 16 (c) The student's birth date. (d) The student's school district of enrollment. 17 (e) The student's school district of residence. 18 (f) The student's highest secondary school grade completed. 19

(g) If applicable, the student's year of high school graduation.

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(h) If the student participated in a program under s. TCS 9.03(1)(a) or (b), the technical college district course or courses the student completed. The course or courses listed under this paragraph shall include the course number and title.

- (i) If the pupil participated in a program under s. TCS 9.03(1)(c), the secondary course or courses the pupil completed for which advanced standing or transcripted credit was received. The course or courses listed under this paragraph shall include the course number and title as specified under the articulation agreement between the technical college and the school district.
- (j) If a student received postsecondary credits for a course or courses under pars. (h) and (i), the number of postsecondary credits awarded.
- (3) Collection of personally identifiable information under sub. (2) shall be used solely for determining student participation in technical college courses or programs under the compulsory education provisions of ss. 118.15(1)(b), (cm), and (d), and the number of students participating in the postsecondary enrollment options program under the provisions of s. 118.37, Stats., and the number of students participating in technical preparation programs under s. 118.34, Stats., including the number of courses taken for advanced standing in a technical college district's associate degree or vocational diploma program and for postsecondary credit.
