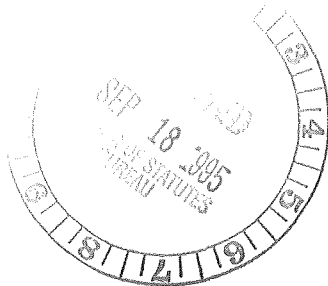

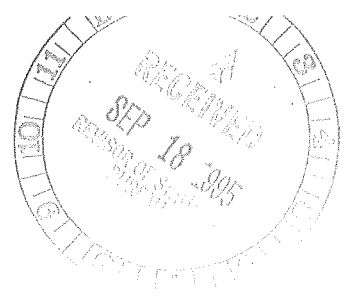

ORDER

An order of the Psychology Examining Board to create Psy 4.02 (5) and (6) relating to the biennial training requirement for psychologists.

ANALYSIS

Statutes authorizing promulgation: ss. 15.08 (5) (b), 227.11 (2) and 455.065 (5), Stats.  
Statutes interpreted: s. 455.065 (5), Stats.

In this proposed rule-making order the Psychology Examining Board creates rules relating to the biennial training requirements for psychologists. These rules are as a result of 1993 Wisconsin Act 445, which made changes to the requirements for community mental health programs approved by the Department of Health and Social Services and created a new provision which requires the Psychology Examining Board to promulgate rules relating to the biennial training requirements.

In cooperation with the Department of Health & Social Services, sec. Psy 4.02 (5) is created to allow the board to accept continuing psychology education credits for voluntary, uncompensated services provided by psychologists who are assisting the Department of Health and Social Services in the evaluation of community outpatient mental health programs approved by the Department of Health and Social Services.

In cooperation with the Department of Health & Social Services, sec. Psy 4.02 (6) is created to define the maximum number of continuing education program hours that could be applied under the categories of self-developed, voluntary, uncompensated services or a combination of self-developed and voluntary uncompensated services.

TEXT OF RULE

SECTION 1. Psy 4.02 (5) and (6) are created to read:

Psy 4.02 (5) APPROVAL OF UNCOMPENSATED EVALUATION ASSISTANCE SERVICES. (a) The board shall accept for continuing education credit voluntary, uncompensated services provided by psychologists in assisting the department of health and

social services in the evaluation of community outpatient mental health programs, as defined in s. 51.01 (3n), Stats., and approved by the department of health and social services according to rules promulgated under s. 51.42 (7) (b), Stats. Four hours of assistance, including hours expended in necessary training by the department of health and human services, shall be deemed to equal one hour of acceptable continuing education for the purposes of this section.

(b) Psychologists wishing to apply for continuing education credit under this subsection shall register in advance with the board, and shall notify the board on forms provided by the board of the dates and the total number of hours in any biennium for which the applicant will be available to provide assistance. The board shall make referrals to the department of health and social services in the order received pursuant to requests for assistance received by the board from that department.



(6) LIMITATION ON CREDIT. The board may grant no more than 20 hours of continuing education credit per biennium for self-developed continuing education programs, no more than 20 hours of credit for uncompensated evaluation assistance services, and no more than 20 hours of credit for any combination of self-developed continuing education programs and uncompensated evaluation assistance services.

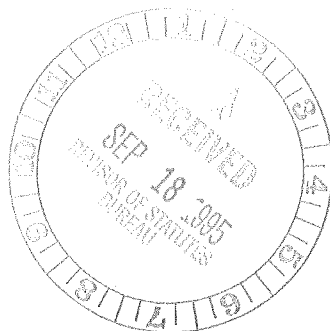

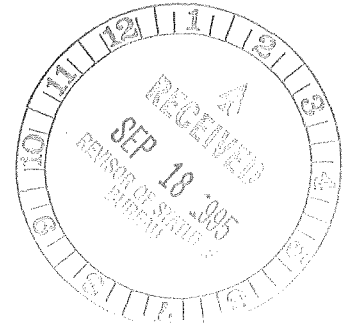
