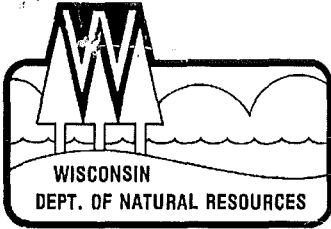

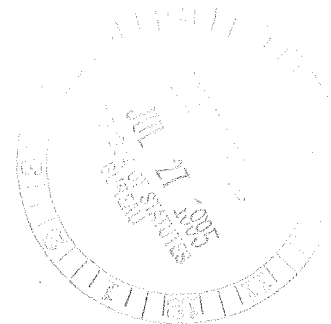

repeal s. NR 20.03(1)(g), (o) and (7) and NR 26.01(52); to
amend NR 20.015(9), 20.03(1)(intro.), (a)1.b., c., d., f., 5m.,
and 6., (c)8., (k), (2), (4)(g)table 1, (6)(c)1., (d)1. and 2.,
20.04(4)(a)5., 23.07, 26.08(13)(a)2., and 26.19(64)(d);
to repeal and recreate NR 20.03(1)(i), (l), (m), and (n);
and to create 20.03(1)(c)10e., (6)(d)2w., 20.07(11),
26.22(64)(b), and 26.30 relating to sport fishing and fish
refuges

Analysis prepared by the Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174 and 227.11(2)(a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.085 and 29.174(2)(a), Stats.

In this order:

Section 1 corrects the definition of safe harvest;

Section 2 corrects a cross-reference. The current reference does not exist;

Section 3 eliminates the 16 inch minimum length limit for largemouth bass on Pretty lake, Waukesha county;

Section 4 eliminates the 12 to 16 inch slot length limit for largemouth and smallmouth bass on Kimball and Mueller lakes, Langlade county;

Section 5 establishes an 18 inch minimum length limit and a daily bag limit of 1 fish for largemouth and smallmouth bass on 21 lakes in Forest, Oneida, and Vilas counties, corrects the spelling of Cochram lake and includes a legal description for Bass lake (Price county);

Section 6 includes a legal description for Bass lake (Bayfield county) and establishes a 15 inch minimum length limit and a daily bag limit of 2 fish for largemouth and smallmouth bass in the Turtle-Flambeau flowage, Iron county;

Section 7 deletes unnecessary wording under Columbia lake (Columbia county);

Sections 8 and 26 include a legal description for Little Bass lake (Oneida county), deletes a reference to nonexistent code, and re-establishes the gear restriction for artificial lures only. These lakes are currently restricted to artificial lures only in NR 20.03(4)(g) Table 1;

Section 9 deletes a reference to an expired date of season closures for Delavan Lake;

Section 10 establishes a 14" to 18" protected slot length limit and a daily bag limit of 3, of which only 1 may be longer than 18", for walleye in the Eagle River chain of lakes and Three Lakes chain of lakes, Oneida and Vilas counties;

Sections 11 and 19 open the south basin of Trout lake, Vilas county, to lake trout fishing and establish a minimum length limit for lake trout of 30 inches for the entire lake, and move restrictions on lake trout harvest in Palette lake to the appropriate table;

Section 12 creates a daily bag limit of 3 and a minimum size limit of 18 inches for white bass in Columbia lake (Columbia county) to coincide with the existing daily bag and size limits for striped bass, a species that is very similar in appearance;

Section 13 deletes bullheads, which appear twice in this table, from the list of panfish, deletes expired season closure on Delavan lake, adds bullheads to the total daily bag for panfish in urban waters, establishes a separate subdivision for lake Wazee, which was not intended to include bullheads in the daily bag limit, establishes a daily bag limit of 10 bluegill, crappie, pumpkinseed (sunfish), and yellow perch in total for Newman lake, Price county, establishes a daily bag limit of 10 bluegill, crappie, pumpkinseed (sunfish), and yellow perch in total and a minimum length limit of 10 inches for crappie in Turtle-Flambeau flowage, Iron county, changes the word aggregate to total and rennumbers subdivisions;

Section 14 creates a daily bag limit of 3 and a minimum size limit of 18 inches for yellow bass in Columbia lake (Columbia county) to coincide with the existing daily bag and size limits for striped bass, a species that is very similar in appearance;

Section 15 repeals and recreates NR 20.03(1)(m) to include panfish in the daily bag limit for bullheads in urban waters;

Section 16 establishes a daily bag limit of 10 whitefish and cisco for Trout lake, Vilas county;

Section 17 repeals the open season, daily bag limit, and minimum length for paddlefish (spoonbill catfish), which appears twice in this table;

Section 18 corrects the description of the closed portion of the Chippewa flowage and Chippewa river;

Section 19 makes several changes to the trout fishing regulations. Adams county: Little Roche a Cri creek from category 2 to 5; Neenah creek to 1 fish over 18". Barron county: Extend the trout fishing season (first Saturday in May to March 1) on Little Granite lake. Columbia county: Rowan creek to category 3; Rowley creek from category 3 to 4. Dane county: Open lakes and ponds to early trout fishing (January 1 to Sept 30). Dunn county: Elk creek from 1 over 18" to 3 fish under 14" or 2 fish under 14" and 1 over 14"; Change the trout regulation category from 5 to 2 on the Red Cedar river. Florence county: Add Chipmunk creek as category 2; Patten lake from category 1 to 2; delete duplicate Sand lake; Wisconsin creek from category 2 to 4. Forest county: Change the minimum length limit for brown trout in Lucerne lake from 15 inches to 16 inches; Extend the season to Nov. 15 on Peshtigo river; Change the slot limit on Otter creek (north) from 9-12" to 10-14". Lanlade county: Extend the season to Nov. 15 on Wolf river. Lincoln county: Add Hilts lake as a category 5 water with an extended season (first Saturday in May to March 1), a daily bag limit of 3 trout and a minimum size limit of 12"; remove the artificial lures-only restriction on Long and Bass lakes. Marathon county: Add Jacobson springs as a category 3 water; change the trout regulation category on Silent springs from 5 to 3. Marinette county: Extend the season to Nov. 15 on Peshtigo river; Marquette county: Neenah creek, upstream from STH 82, changes to 1 fish over 18". Oconto county: All waters not listed from category 1 to 2; Delete Kathleen lake - no longer managed for trout; Oconto river (portion of the south branch) reduce the daily bag limit from 3 to 1, increase minimum length limit for brook trout from 10" to 12" and for brown trout from 13" to 18"; Thunder river (north fork) from category 2 to 4; Waupee creek from category 2 to 4. Oneida county: Delete Bird lake from the table. Portage county: Little Wolf river from category 2 to 4; Change the boundary between the category 3 and category 5 sections on the Tomorrow river; Tomorrow river (upper) from category 3 to 4 and add a category 5 section from Clementson road upstream to confluence with Poncho creek, Artificial lures only, daily bag limit: 1 trout, size limit: brown trout 14", brook trout 10". Richland county: Correct spelling of Grinsell creek and changes from 10-18" protected slot length limit for brook trout to 10-14" protected slot length limit. Rock county: Open lakes and ponds in Rock county to early trout fishing (January 1 to Sept 30).

Sauk county: Beaver creek to catch and release; Boulder creek from category 5 to 3; Camels creek to catch and release; Dell creek from category 5 and 4 to 3; Extend the trout season on Devil's lake (first Saturday in May to March 1); Honey creek from category 4 to 3; Leech creek from category 4 to 3; Little Baraboo river from category 5 to 3; Manley creek from category 5 to 3; Otter creek from category 5 to 3; Parfrey's Glen creek from category 5 to 3; Rowley creek from category 5 to 4.

Shawano county: All waters not listed from category 1 to 2; correct the spelling of Homme pond. Sheboygan county: Remove Big Elkhart and Butler lakes from the table. St. Croix county: Anderson springs from category 3 to 2; add Race branch to Willow river and change from category 3 to 5 (artificials only except from top of Little Falls dam with a daily bag limit of 1 fish and a minimum size limit of 16"). Vilas county: Remove Papoose lake from the table; Open south basin of Trout lake to lake trout fishing with a minimum length limit of 30" and a daily bag limit of 1 fish; include restrictions on lake trout harvest in Palette lake here in the appropriate table. Waupaca county: Remove the 45-inch cumulative length limit on 5 waters; Little Wolf river from category 4 to 5 (artificial lures only, size limit 14" on brook trout, bag limit 1 fish); Radley creek from category 2 or 4 (in part) to 3 (entire creek); Waupaca river (portion) from category 4 to 5 (artificial lures only, bag limit 1 fish, size limit 10" brook trout, 18" brown trout). Waushara county: Remove the 45-inch cumulative length limit from 6 waters, changing these waters to category 2; correct the title of Wild Rose mill pond. Wood county: Change a portion of Ten Mile creek from trout regulation category 3 to category 2;

Section 20 opens Nancy lake, Washburn county, to muskellunge fishing;

Section 21 establishes a 40 inch minimum length limit for muskellunge in lake Galilee, Ashland county; Bony, Middle Eau Claire, Pike lake chain, and Upper Eau Claire lakes, Bayfield county; Lower Eau Claire lake, Douglas county; Catherine, Cedar, Fisher, and Long lakes, Iron county; Cloverleaf lakes, Shawano, and Washington lakes, Shawano county; and Nancy lake, Washburn county; and eliminates a 40 inch minimum length limit for muskellunge in Namekagon lake, Bayfield county;

Section 22 creates subdivision paragraphs for an existing table.

Section 23 re-establishes the minimum length limit of 36 inches for muskellunge in Nemadji river, Allouez bay, Little Pokegama bay, Pokegama bay, and Kimballs bay (Douglas county). This rule was established by order FM-50-88 and was inadvertently deleted in order FM-17-91;

Section 24 repeals a provision that was effective only through September 30, 1991;

Section 25 corrects the lake trout fishing season on Palette lake, Vilas county, by extending the closure indefinitely. This change was made by order FM-35-91, but revisions to this section were overlooked at that time;

Section 27 eliminates the harvest of fish other than smelt by seine, net, or trap from the Montreal river downstream from the Superior Falls dam;

Sections 28 and 32 remove the December 31, 1995 sunset on the fish refuge at the Root river steelhead facility, change the refuge boundaries and establish a refuge from August 1 to the Friday before the first Saturday in May upstream and downstream of the facility;

Section 29 extends the fish refuge in the village of McFarland, Dane county, upstream to the lock and dam;

Section 30 corrects the legal description of the refuge at the outlet of Little Arbor Vitae lake, Vilas county, extends the refuge downstream and Carrol lake, and excludes 2 unnamed lakes;

Section 31 creates a fish refuge from April 10 to May 15 each year on Allequash creek, Vilas county, beginning at County Highway M and extending downstream to Trout lake and into Trout lake for a distance of 100 feet in all directions.

SECTION 1. NR 20.015(9) is amended to read:

NR 20.015 (9) "Safe harvest" means a level of harvest that incorporates an appropriate margin of safety, estimates of the population and acceptable exploitation rates which will reasonably prevent harvest of more than 35% of the population of adult walleyes or 27% of the population of adult muskellunge. The margin of safety assures that the true safe harvest is not exceeded in more than 1 of 40 cases. For waters where a population estimate has not been made, a regression model based upon population estimates from other waters will be used. ~~The margin of safety used depends upon the age of the population estimate was made and whether a regression model was used.~~

SECTION 2. NR 20.03(1)(intro.) is amended to read:

NR 20.03 **Season tables; open and closed seasons, size and bag limits and measurements.** (1)(intro.) The open seasons specified in the following table apply to fishing in open waters and fishing through the ice. The department may, following scientific investigation and study, establish bag limits and size limits on the individual inland waters when it finds that the taking of fish will aid in management of the fishery and insure the citizens of this state additional opportunities for good fishing. Such special regulations shall become effective only after public informational meetings are held. The department may also establish an urban fishing program by posting the open and closed seasons on specified waters. For open seasons in specified waters see s. NR 20.04. The possession limit for each species of fish, except trout as specified in sub. ~~(5)~~(4), shall be double the daily bag limit specified in this chapter except that no person may have in possession or under control more than the daily bag limit while on the ice or waters or while fishing in the state of Wisconsin unless the person holds a permit issued by the department under this section and s. NR 19.05 for restocking of fish caught in a fishing tournament or holds a permit or license which authorizes possession of a greater number under s. 29.135, 29.513, 29.52 or 29.535, Stats. The measurement of all fish taken shall be in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the utmost end of the tail fin fully extended.

NR 26.22(64) (b) *Allequash creek*. That part of Allequash creek beginning at county highway M, NW1/4 of the NW1/4, section 20, township 41 north, range 7 east, extending downstream to Trout lake and into Trout lake for a distance of 100 feet in all directions.

SECTION 32. NR 26.30 is created to read:

NR 26.30 Fish Refuges. The following described areas are created and established as fish refuges and no person may take, disturb, catch, capture, kill or fish for fish in any manner from August 1 to the Friday before the first Saturday in May, each year, both dates inclusive, in, on, or along the following described areas:

(52) RACINE COUNTY. (a) That part of the Root river located at Lincoln park in the city of Racine beginning 200 feet downstream from the fish ladder and extending upstream to 100 feet past the instream fish barrier of the Root river steelhead facility.

(b) That part of the Root river located at Lincoln park in the city of Racine beginning 100 feet downstream from the fish return pipe and extending upstream to 100 feet past the fish return pipe of the Root river steelhead facility.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on May 25, 1995.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on April 1, 1996, except for subdivisions 13., 53. and 55. in SECTION 19, which shall take effect on January 1, 1996, as provided by s. 227.22(2) (b), Stats.
