





ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
AMENDING RULES



The Wisconsin Natural Resources Board adopts
an order to amend NR 20.03 (1)(q) 1. a. relating
to hook and line sturgeon angling

FM-31-94

Analysis Prepared by Department of Natural Resources

Statutory authority: ss. 29.174 (3) and 227.11 (2) (a), Stats.

Statutes interpreted: ss. 29.174 (2) (a), Stats.

In this order, the proposed rule would prohibit angling for lake sturgeon in all waters of Menominee County.

SECTION 1. NR 20.03 (1) (q) 1. a. is amended to read:

(q) ROCK AND LAKE STURGEON

1. Hook and line season

a. In all waters except Lakes Poygan, Winneconne, Butte des Morts, Winnebago and connecting waters; in the Embarrass river from the Pella dam, Shawano county downstream to its confluence with the Wolf river in Outagamie county; in the Shioc river from the Outagamie-Shawano county line downstream to its confluence with the Wolf river, in the Little Wolf river from the Manawa dam, Waupaca county downstream to its confluence with the Wolf river in Waupaca county; the Wolf river from	First Saturday in September to October 15	1 per season	50

downstream to Lake Poygan; and the Fox river
downstream from milepost No. 63,
commonly known as Johnson creek
in Green Lake county to Lake
Butte des Morts; in the St. Croix
river from Upper St. Croix lake,
Douglas county downstream to the
Minnesota state line; in the
Namekagon river from Namekagon
lake, Bayfield county downstream
to its confluence with the St.
Croix river in Burnett county,
in the Totagatic river from
Totagatic lake, Bayfield county
downstream to its confluence
with the Namekagon river in
Burnett county; and the Nemadji
river, Allouez bay, Little
Pokegama bay, Pokegama bay and
Kimballs bay, Douglas county; Wisconsin
river, from the dam in Wisconsin Dells
upstream to its origin, including all
flowages and tributaries upstream to the
first dam or highway bridge on the
tributary; and all other waters of
Menominee county.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board
on August 18, 1995.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1996, pursuant to authority granted by s. 227.22(2)(b),
Stats.
