## **EXECUTIVE ORDER #193**

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Former Representative Tamara Grigsby of the 18th Assembly District

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2016, Representative Tamara Grigsby passed away unexpectedly at the age of 41, following a battle with illness; and

WHEREAS, Representative Tamara Grigsby served in the Wisconsin State Assembly from 2005 until 2013, representing the people of the 18th Assembly District; and

**WHEREAS,** before her election in 2004, Representative Tamara Grigsby served her community and the people of Milwaukee as a Program Manager with the Wisconsin Council on Children and Families; and

WHEREAS, as a member of the Assembly, Representative Tamara Grigsby served on the Joint Finance Committee and helped to create the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families in 2008; and

WHEREAS, since stepping down from the Assembly, Representative Tamara Grigsby continued to serve the public, working in the office of the Dane County Executive and serving as director of the Dane County Department of Equality and Inclusion; and

WHEREAS, Representative Tamara Grigsby was a dedicated public servant, and the people of Wisconsin mourn her passing; and

**WHEREAS,** a memorial service will be held for Representative Tamara Grigsby on Thursday, March 31, 2016;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on Thursday, March 31, 2016, and ending at sunset on that date.
