

EXECUTIVE ORDER #238

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin May Be Flown at Half-Staff in the City of Franklin as a Mark of Respect for Detective Kevin Liermann

WHEREAS, on Saturday, March 25, 2017, Detective Kevin Liermann of the Franklin Police Department passed away at the young age of 39; and

WHEREAS, Detective Kevin Liermann honorably served the City of Franklin and the State of Wisconsin during his seventeen years with the Franklin Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Detective Kevin Liermann leaves behind a loving wife and two daughters; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin honor his legacy and mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, the local community has petitioned the Office of the Governor to permit the lowering of the flags in the City of Franklin;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff in Franklin, Wisconsin, beginning immediately and ending at sunset on Saturday, April 1, 2017.
