Statutory Authority: Sections 41.41(7)(k)

Explanation of agency authority:

Section 41.41(7)(k), Stats., provides that the Kickapoo Reserve Management Board "Prules that are applicable only to land in the Kickapoo valley reserve and other land acquithe board, facilities on that land and waters adjacent to that land establishing restriction of the land, waters and facilities."

Related Statute or rule:

Section 175.60, Stats, relating to firearms as permitted.

Plain language analysis:

Original rule defining campsite occupancy limit to 6 persons or fewer are inconsistent v current management of campsites. Change in rule would set occupancy limits by posted Also, existing rule prohibiting firearms on the Kickapoo Valley Reserve is inconsistent States' Concealed Carry Law.

TEXT OF RULE

Section 1. KB 1.02 (10 is amended to read:

KB 1.02 (1) "Backpack campsite" means an area designated for camping that has no veraccess to or near the area, to which all supplies are carried by foot, and that may be occord one camping party consisting of an immediate family or a group of 6 or fewer persons on the all from the same immediate family.

Section 2. KB 1.02 (5) is amended to read:

KB 1.02 (5) "Camping party" means the occupant of a backpack campsite, a campsite campsite consisting of members of an immediate family, a group of 6 or fewer persons not all from the same immediate family, or a group of 7 or more persons who either bell organization or an extended family.

Section 3. KB 1.02 (6) is amended to read:

(6) "Campsite" means an area, other than a backpack campsite, designated for camping posted group size limit of two vehicles and one camping party consisting of an immediat or a group of 6 or fewer persons who are not all from the same immediate family unless designated as a group campsite.

Section 4. KB 1.02 (12) is amended to read:

KB 1.02 (12) "Group campsite" means any tract of land designated for camping by a g or more persons who belong to an organization or extended family that has obtained an permit approved by the property manager of the reserve.

KB 1.03 (1) (c) is amended to read:

KB 1.03 (1) (c) A group may reserve an area for a special event through application to Reservations are restricted to groups of 25 or more individuals. The board may deny per groups hosting activities that do not meet the objective of the reserve identified in s. 41 Stats., or this chapter.

KB 1.08 (2) No person may possess any loaded or uncased firearm or air gun while wireserve except as follows: Firearms are permitted as provided under s. 175.60, Stats., or the following circumstances apply:

KB 1.09 (8)

KB 1.09 (8) No more than one camping party is permitted at any camping site in the recamping party that includes persons other than immediate family members may not. 6 percept a camping party that receives a permit to camp at a group campsite exceed the p occupancy limit.
