NOTICE OF SUBMITTAL OF RULES TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL RULES CLEARINGHOUSE

Chapter PI 25, Children at Risk Plan and Program

On October 3, 2017, the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction submitted a proposed rule to the Wisconsin Legislative Council Rules Clearinghouse.

The scope statement for this rule, SS 101-17, was published in Register No. 741A3, on September 18, 2017, and approved by State Superintendent Tony Evers on October 3, 2017. Pursuant to *Coyne v*. *Walker*, the Department of Public Instruction is not required to obtain the Governor's approval for the statement of scope for this rule. <u>Coyne v. Walker</u>, 368 Wis.2d 444.

The proposed rule amends ch. PI 25, relating to children at risk plans.

The rules are being adopted under s. 227.16 (2) (b), Stats., which provides that rulemaking does not need to be preceded by notice and public hearing if the proposed rule brings an existing rule into conformity with a statute that has been changed.
