EXECUTIVE ORDER #292

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the
Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for
Peace Officers Who Have Given Their Lives in the Line of Duty**

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin is served by the peace officers who have sworn to protect and serve its communities; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's peace officers dedicate themselves and their careers to the pursuit of service, safety, and justice, despite the danger to their own lives; and

WHEREAS, we remember and honor the bravery of the peace officers who serve and have served the State of Wisconsin, and those who have made the ultimate sacrifice for the sake of those they protect; and


WHEREAS, in 1962, President John F. Kennedy designated May 15 of each year as Peace Officers' Memorial Day and designated the week in which it occurs as Police Week, requiring the flag of the United States to be flown at half-staff on May 15 in recognition of peace officers who have given their lives in the line of duty;

NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of this State, do hereby:


1. Order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin located in the State beginning at sunrise on **Tuesday, May 15, 2018**, and ending at sunset on that date.
2. Authorize any jurisdiction of this State to fly the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin at half-staff on any day during Police Week (May 13, 2018 through May 19, 2018) for the purpose of honoring, in a public ceremony, peace officers who have given their lives in the line of duty.
