

EXECUTIVE ORDER #297

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Captain Cory Barr of the Sun Prairie Volunteer Fire Department

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2018, Captain Cory Barr, a firefighter with the Sun Prairie Volunteer Fire Department, died while responding to a gas leak in downtown Sun Prairie, Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Captain Cory Barr was heroic in his actions on July 10, 2018, responding to the gas leak while off-duty to evacuate residents and bystanders from the area, helping countless others in the face of imminent danger; and

WHEREAS, Captain Cory Barr leaves behind a legacy of selflessness, service and commitment to his community, marked by 15 years of service with the Sun Prairie Volunteer Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Captain Cory Barr; and

WHEREAS, a memorial service will be held for Captain Cory Barr on Saturday, July 14, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution, the laws of this State, and by federal law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning immediately and ending at sunset on Saturday, July 14, 2018.
