Summary of Conduit Revenue Bonds

This is a proposed guidance document. The document has been submitted to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Administrative Register for public comment as provided by sec. <u>227.112(1)</u>, Wis. Stats.

- 1. What are "conduit revenue bonds"?
- 2. What conduit revenue bonds have been issued and is the interest from the bonds exempt from Wisconsin tax?
- 1. **What are "conduit revenue bonds"?**Bonds or notes issued, by a commission (organized under <u>sec. 66.0304</u>, Wis. Stats.) that consists of government agencies, to fund certain projects.
- 2. What conduit revenue bonds have been issued and is the interest from the bonds exempt from Wisconsin tax?

A commission (entity created by two or more political subdivisions, which contract with each other under <u>sec. 66.0301(2)</u> or <u>66.0303(2)</u>, Wis. Stats.) is required to notify the Department of Revenue when a bond is issued. A summary of bonds issued and the tax status of interest from the bonds is available on the <u>Individual Income Tax Conduit Revenue Bonds</u> page.
