Chap. 100

Ream, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of four hundred dollars, in full pay and compensation for furnishing four large manuscript sectional maps of the State of Wisconsin, ordered by the Secretary of State, in accordance with the provisions of an act approved February ninth, eighteen hundred and fifty.

An Act to appropriate to John F. Lessey, former Sheriff of Brown county, the sum therein named.

Chap. 101

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to John F. Lessey, former sheriff of the county of Brown, the sum of fifty-three dollars and fifty cents, to be paid out of any money in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated, for arresting, by request of the officers of the land office at Green Bay, and in accordance with the Governor's requisition, and conveying him to Milwaukee for examination, a German having in his possession a land warrant belonging to Adolph Briggs, a German who was murdered near Milwaukee.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated to John F. Lessey, former Sheriff of the county of Brown, the sum of one hundred
