

Chap. 105

An Act to appropriate to R. W. Lansing a certain sum of money.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated to R. W. Lansing, the sum of one hundred and twenty-five dollars, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, in full for services in arranging, paging, indexing and title-paging, putting up and labelling for book-binder, the "Laws, Resolutions and Memorials of the Territory and State of Wisconsin," done by order of the Secretary of State, under the provisions of section fourteen, of chapter nine, of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.
