Chap. 138

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate

and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That Burr S. Craft, Clark Knight, and George M. Lowe be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road from the Grand Kauhana, in the county of Brown, to the Oneida settlement, passing through towns twenty-one and twenty-two, north range, eighteen east, and towns twenty-one, range nineteen east.

SEC. 2. The commissioners, for laying out said road, shall receive such compensation as the board of Supervisors of the county of Brown may determine: Provided, That no part of the expense of laying out said road shall be paid out of the
