Chap. 216

An Act for the relief of Sheboygan county.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Certain State officers to correct accounts vs the county.

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby authorised and empowered, on his being furnished with satisfactory proof by the Supervisors of Sheboygan county, to certify the amount now standing against said county, for arrearages of taxes that have resulted from double assessment and taxation of property in said county, and the State Treasurer is hereby required to credit the amount so certified to the county of Sheboygan.

An Act to attach certain territory therein named to the town of Bloomingdale

Territory attached.

SECTION 1. That all the territory west of Fox river falling within the limits of town eighteen, of range fifteen, in the county of Winnebago be, and the same is attached, for all town purposes, to the town of Bloomingdale.

Chap. 218

An Act to authorise the laying out of a State Road therein described.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

Commissioners appointed to lay out road.

SECTION 1. That Christian Linde, William N. Davis and N. E. Hobart, be, and are appointed Commissioners to lay out

and establish a state road from Oshkosh in the county of Winnebago, on the most practicable route to Little Bull Falls on the Wisconsin river.

SEC. 2. The Commissioners aforesaid shall receive for their services such compensation as may be determined by the Supervisors of the counties through which said road may pass: Compensation—how to be made. Provided, that no part of the expense of laying out said road Proviso. shall be paid out of the State Treasury.

An Act to provide for the laying out and establishing of certain roads therein named. **Chap. 219**

*The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That Daniel D. Billings, James C. Edson and Zenas C. German, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road commencing at the bridge over the Wisconsin river, at or near the Dells on the same, thence running on the east side of said river as near the same as may be practicable, to Point Boss, thence running to Grand Rapids in the county of Portage. Commissioners appointed to lay out a road. Route.

SEC. 2. That J. Utley, William Rogan and Alford P. Foster, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out and establish a state road commencing at Fort Winnebago, thence through Pardeeville on the most feasible route to certain state road near the centre of section thirty four (34) in the town of Springvale, in the county of Columbia: Provided, That no part of the expense of laying out said road shall be paid out of the State Treasury. Commissioners appointed to lay out a road. Route. Proviso.
