Chap. 817

An Act to appropriate to J. C. Fairchild the sum therein named.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. That the sum of fifty-seven dollars and eighty cents is hereby appropriated to J. C. Fairchild, to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, in full for postage for the office of State Treasurer, for the year eighteen hundred and fifty.

Chap. 318

An Act further to appropriate money to pay the contingent expenses of the State Superintendent of Public Instruction for the year 1850.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to E. Root, State Superintendent of Public Instruction, the sum of five hundred and eighty-four dollars and seventy-five cents, to be paid out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, in full pay and satisfaction for the balance of the contingent expenses of his office for the year 1850, including clerk hire, office rent, express freights, telegraphing and traveling expenses.
