Chap. 324

An Act to incorporate the North-Western Art Union.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate

and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Incorporation.

SECTION 1. That John H. Tweedy, Rufus King, Increase A. Laphand, Paraclete Potter, Benjamin H. Boynton, William E. Cramer, George H. Walker, Oliver G. Hillard, Leonard J. Farwell, John Huestis, Jeremiah B. Selby, Jr., William H. Watson, John K. Bartlett, Philetus C. Hale, Charles H. Williams, Lucas Seaver, and such other persons as now are, or may hereafter from time to time become associated with them, are hereby constituted a body corporate, by the name of the "North-Western Art Union," for the purposes of promoting the fine arts.

Election of Committee of Management how made. SEC. 2. The business of said corporation shall be conducted by a committee of management, to consist of fifteen members who are not professional artists, who shall be chosen at the annual meetings of the association, as follows: At the first meeting to be held pursuant to public notice by a majority of the persons above named; there shall be chosen fifteen members of such committee, who shall be divided by lot into three
