

## Chap. 39.

An Act providing for the election of a Chief Justice.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. Whenever a vacancy shall exist in the office of Chief Justice, the Judges of the Supreme Court shall elect by ballot one of their number to fill said office ; but no election shall take place unless four of their number concur in a choice.

SEC. 2. This act shall be published immediately after its passage, in the State paper, and shall take effect on being so published.

Chap. 40. An Act to appropriate to the legal representatives of Jackson Richardson, deceased, a certain sum of money.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the legal representatives of Jackson Richardson, deceased, seventy-two dollars and fifty cents, in full for support of state prisoners, David J. Odel and Levi Bates, from November tenth, eighteen hundred forty-nine, to February twentieth, eighteen hundred fifty, to be paid out of any funds in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated.
