

An Act to appropriate to James Campbell a certain sum of money therein named. **Chap. 406**

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to James Campbell, the sum of one hundred and sixty-eight dollars, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, in full payment for furniture ordered by Mr. Hudson for the office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction, and for materials and work ordered by the Secretary of State for the year A. D., one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
