An Act to authorize the Town Superintendent of the Town of Green Lake to apportion School moneys to School District Number Two, in said town.

Chap 215

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The town superintendent of the town of Green Lake, Marquette county, is hereby authorized and required, at the next apportionment of school moneys in said town, to apportion to school district number two (2) in said town, such share of such school moneys as it would be entitled to if the whole amount said district received for the last year from the income of the school fund had been expended for teachers' wages. Superintendent to apportion money.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

An Act to amend title twenty-two, chapter eighty-six, section seventeen of the Revised Statutes.

Chap 216

SECTION 1. That title twenty-two, chapter eighty-six, section seventeen, of the revised statutes, be and the same is hereby so amended that the demand for a jury may be made at any time between the joining of issue and the commencement of the trial, notwithstanding an adjournment of the cause may have intervened.

Chap 217 An Act to authorize the Board of Public Works to construct a Draw Bridge across the Portage Canal.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Authorized to
construct bridge

SECTION 1. The board of public works, for the improvement of the Fox and Wisconsin rivers, are authorized and instructed to make a contract for the construction of a draw bridge across the Portage canal, and to locate the same on Main Street, in what is called Portage City, in the town of Fort Winnebago; said point of location is known to the traveling public as being upon the main road to the Wisconsin pinery.

Chap 218 An Act authorizing Fordyce S. Richards to establish and maintain a Ferry across the Mississippi river at the foot of Lake Pepin.

The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

May keep ferry.

SECTION 1. That Fordyce S. Richards, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, shall have the right and privilege, for the period of ten years, of keeping and maintaining a ferry across the Mississippi river, in the county of Chippewa, at or near the foot of Lake Pepin, and no other ferry shall be established within one mile of said ferry, either above or below the same.

SECTION 2. Said Fordyce S. Richards shall, at all times keep good boats in good repair, sufficient for the accommodation of all persons wishing to cross at said ferry, and shall give prompt and ready attendance on passengers or teams, on
