An Act to amend section 21, chapter 103, also section 12, chapter 131, of the Revised Chap 425

Section twenty-one of chapter one hundred act amended, and two of the revised statutes, is hereby amended so as to read as follows: such acknowledgment shall be made before some judge of the court in which the judgment was rendered, or before some judge of the circuit court or court commissioner, or before any other officer duly qualified by law to take the acknowledgment of deeds, who shall certify that the party making the same was known or was made known to such officer by competent proof.
