## Chap 461

An Act to appropriate to John Taylor the sum therein named.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to John Taylor, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred and ninety-five dollars and sixty cents, in full payment for time and expenses in visiting eastern state prisons and procuring plans thereof, for the use of state prison commissioners of this state.

## Chap 462

An Act to provide for the taxation of all property in this State.

*The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly do enact as follows:*

Act repealed. SECTION 1. Chapter 267 of the statutes of the state of Wisconsin in the year 1850, entitled, "An act to amend the existing laws relating to the assessment and taxation of personal property," is hereby repealed.

Acts revived. SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts altering, amending, or repealing in any manner, chapter fifteen, title five, of the revised statutes of the state of Wisconsin, entitled, "Of the assessment and collection of taxes," or of any part thereof, are hereby repealed, and all those provisions of said chapter fifteen, title five, of said revised statutes, heretofore altered, amended, or repealed by any act or acts, are hereby revived and declared to be in force.

Amount of tax ascertained. SEC. 3. The assessor in each town or ward shall proceed, at the time prescribed in section sixteen of said chapter fifteen, title five, of the revised statutes, to the
