An Act to appropriate certain sums of money to the Wisconsin Institute for the Blind.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Wiscon-Appropriation, sin institute for the Blind, the sum of four thousand dollars, for the support of said Institute from the first day of October next to the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven; and whereas the fiscal year for said institute has heretofore comenced on the first day of October, and the appropriations heretofore made for its When fiscal yearshall com- support extend to the first day of October next, the fiscal mence. year of said Institute shall hereafter commence on the first day of January.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated to said institution the further sum of five thousand dollars, to aid in the completion of the main building and the east wing for said in-This last stitution, according to the plan of the same. When to be named sum of five thousand dollars shall be paid out of the tax assessed in the year eighteen hundred and fiftyfive and paid into the treasury in the year eighteen hundred and fifty six.

SEC. 3. Before the receipt of the respective sums of money appropriated by this act, the board of trustees of said institution shall from time to time, execute such bonds and sureties as the Governor may require and approve, conditioned, for the faithful application of such moneys to the object specified in this act.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
