CHAPTER 141.

An Act to authorize Secretary of State to audit certain accounts of Registers' of Deeds and Witnesses.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby authorized to audit the accounts of the registers' of deeds of the several counties in this state, from which abstracts of the state mortgages were received by, and for the use of the investigating committee, at the several sums specified in the report of the secretary of the said committee, and also the accounts of witnesses which were subpoenaed and examined before said committee, according to the time and mileage specified in the said report, at the rate of ten cents per mile and two dollars and fifty cents for each day's attendance as therein specified.

Secretary of state to audit certain accounts.

SEC. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, a sufficient sum for the payment of said accounts as audited by the secretary of state.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
