CHAPTER 37.

An Act to change the name of Salena Richardson to Salena Wilson.

The People of the State of Wisconsin represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The name of Salena Richardson, of Black Earth, Dane county, an infant orphan, ten years of age, is hereby changed to Salena Wilson, and by the last mentioned name she shall hereafter be known and recognized. Name changed

SEC. 2. The said Salena Wilson shall be known as the adopted daughter and heir at-law of Charles Wilson and his wife Elizabeth Wilson, of the said town of Black Earth, and as such be entitled to all the rights, privileges and customs, and subject to all the duties of inheritance, support and maintenance as fully and effectually, and in the same manner, as she might or should do, if she were the legitimate child of the said Charles Wilson and Elizabeth Wilson. Heir-at-law.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
