AN ACT to provide blanks for the use of Inspectors and Clerks of general elections.

The people of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

§ 1. It shall be the duty of the Secretary of State to Sec. of State to cause a sufficient number of blank statements of the distribute votes cast for State and County officers at the general elections in this State, to be printed and distributed to the Clerks of the Boards of Supervisors of the several Counties in this State, on or before the first day of August in each year.

§ 2. There shall be two separate forms of such state-Blanks to comments, one for the use of the towns and one for the use certificates of of the wards of the several cities in this State; such clerks, etc., blanks shall contain the necessary oaths and certificates of the Inspectors and Clerks of elections, and shall also contain a note with directions for filling such blanks.

§ 3. Such blank statements shall be distributed to sheriff to distribute the several town and city Clerks in each County by the Sheriffs of the several Counties, at the time that the notices for the general elections are served upon such town and city Clerks, without additional fees or charges therefor.

§ 4. It shall be the duty of such town and city clerks Duty of town and to furnish the Inspectors of election, in their respective towns and wards with such blank statements at or before the time of opening the polls on the day of the general election. And the said Inspectors of election and the Clerks of election shall use such blanks in all statements of the result of such elections which are required to be made by law.

§ 5. No election or election return shall be in any manner invalidated in consequence of the failure to use any blanks provided for by this act.

§ 6. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
