

# GENERAL LAWS.

## CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT to prescribe the time for holding Courts in the Fifth Judicial Circuit.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That hereafter the general terms of the Court in <sup>5th</sup> circuit court in and for the counties of Iowa, Grant and <sup>circuit.</sup> La Fayette, in the Fifth Judicial Circuit of this State, shall be held as follows: In the county of Iowa, on the <sup>Time of hold-</sup> third Monday in February and the third Monday in Sep- <sup>ing same.</sup> tember of each year; in the county of Grant, on the first Monday in March and the first Monday in October of each year; in the county of La Fayette, on the fourth Monday in March and the fourth Monday in October of each year.

SEC. 2. All writs, summons, process, indictments, re- <sup>Writs, &c.</sup> cognizances, and other proceedings made returnable <sup>when return-</sup> to the terms now fixed by law, shall be returnable to the <sup>able,</sup> terms herein provided; and all adjournments, appearances, continuances, motions and notices, of any proceedings in the circuit courts of said counties, made or taken to any term of a date subsequent to the date when this act shall take effect, shall be held and taken for the time herein provided for holding the terms of said courts.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts conflicting with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act, immediately after its passage, shall be <sup>Publication.</sup> published in a newspaper printed in each of the counties of Iowa, Grant and La Fayette, and it is hereby made the duty of the secretary of state to immediately furnish copies of this act to the publishers of papers in said counties for publication.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
