CHAPTER 16.

AN ACT to authorize the state treasurer to retain from the income fund of the university of Wisconsin, a sum sufficient to pay the interest upon all loans made to said university.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the state treasurer to retain from the income fund of the University of Wisconsin an amount sufficient to pay the annual interest upon all loans made to said university from the school, university, and normal school funds, and to apply the same for that purpose, and pay over the remainder of said income to the treasurer of the university, and take his receipt therefor. Interest money retained—
for what purpose.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT to amend chapter 103 of the general laws of 1858, relative to insurance companies.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1, of chapter 103 of the general laws of 1858, is hereby amended by striking out the word "offered," where it occurs in the twentieth line of said section, in the published volume of laws, and inserting the word "reserved;" also by inserting the words "in this state," after the word "agencies," where it occurs in the twenty-fourth line of said sec- How amended
