

fied to him by the clerk of the board of supervisors of the county in which such town is situated, and attach a warrant thereto, and deliver the same to the treasurer of his town as provided by law, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not less than five hundred dollars, nor more than one thousand.

CHAPTER 97.

AN ACT to remit to Andrew Proudft a certain sum of money deposited by him with state treasurer.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to Andrew Proudft out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one thousand dollars, being the amount deposited by him with the state treasurer on the 15th day of December, A D. 1856, in accordance with the provisions of section 6, of chapter 113, of the session laws of 1856.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from **Take effect.** and after its passage.

CHAPTER 98.

AN ACT providing for holding special terms of the circuit court in the counties of La Crosse and Trempeleau, in the sixth judicial circuit.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. There shall be held in the counties of La Crosse and Trempeleau, in the sixth judicial circuit, in **Special term,** this state, at least one special term in La Crosse county in each year, which special term shall be held in the county of La Crosse, at some time other than the regular **whon held.**
