

CHAPTER 13.

[Published January 30, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 22, of the General Laws of 1859, entitled "An act relative to the sale of lands for unpaid taxes, and the conveyance and redemption thereof."

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section thirty-eight, of chapter twenty-two, of the General Laws of 1859, is hereby amended by striking out the words "such deed," at the close of the twenty-third line of said section, and inserting in place thereof, the words "the certificate of sale for taxes upon which such deed was issued."

Amendment to law of 1859, of the sale and conveyance of lands for unpaid taxes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 14.

[Published February 1, 1860.]

AN ACT relative to the printing of public documents.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. That the printing of extra copies of public documents, not now provided for by law, for the use of the Legislature, shall hereafter be authorized only by joint resolution of the Senate and Assembly.

Extra copies of pub. docs. must be ordered by joint resolution.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
