CHAPTER 20.

[Published February 3, 1860.]

AN ACT to authorize the laying out of a state road, from Eau Claire, in Eau Claire county, to Menominee, in Dunn county.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. That L. Bullard, Levi Ramsey and Richard F. Wilson, be, and are hereby appointed, commissioners to lay out and establish a state road, from the village of Eau Claire, in Eau Claire county, by the nearest and most feasible route, to Menominee, in Dunn county, Wisconsin. Commissioners.

SEC. 2. The commissioners shall receive for their services, in laying out said road, such compensation as may be allowed by the board of supervisors of the counties through which said road may pass: *Provided*, that no part of the expense of laying out said road shall be paid out of the State treasury. Their compensation.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT to amend chapter thirteen, of the Revised Statutes, entitled “Of counties and county officers.”

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the clerk of the board of supervisors, to keep a true and accurate account of all moneys which shall come into his hands, by the clerk of the board of supervisors, to keep account of money's received.
