

having claims against the same raft of logs or timber, and take a written assignment of such interest; and it shall be the duty of the person taking such assignment to file the same, with the petition required to be filed by this act; and the assignee is hereby authorized to commence an action, as in this act provided, for the whole of the sum so assigned to him, without making his assignors parties to the action.

SEC. 21. The county court of any county having jurisdiction in civil actions, shall have cognizance and concurrent jurisdiction with the circuit court in all cases arising under this act, when the demand claimed shall not exceed the jurisdiction of said court, and shall be governed by the provisions of this chapter relative to circuit courts.

SEC. 22. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 217.

[Published April 13, 1860.]

AN ACT to amend chapter two, of the Revised Statutes, entitled "Of the division of the State into counties, and their boundaries."

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section forty-six, of chapter two, of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by striking out the words "fourteen and fifteen," in the fifteenth line of said

section, and inserting instead thereof, the words "fifteen and sixteen."

Amends sec. 54. SEC. 2. Section fifty-four, of said chapter, is hereby amended, by inserting between the words "township," and "twenty," in the sixth line of said section, the following words: "twenty-four and twenty-five north, thence east on said township line, to the line between ranges fifteen and sixteen east, thence north on said range line to the township line between townships."

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 218.

[Published April 13, 1860.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of a special tax in that part of joint school district No. 9, in the towns of Fox Lake and Courtland, being in the town of Fox Lake.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Time extended.

SECTION 1. The time for the collection of a special tax in that part of joint school district No. 9, in the towns of Fox Lake and Courtland, being in the town of Fox Lake, is hereby extended to the first day of June, 1860.

Powers of town treasurer.

SEC. 2. The town treasurer of the town of Fox Lake, shall possess all the powers in collecting and making return of the said special tax, that are conferred upon him in collecting any general tax.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
