CHAPTER 269.

AN ACT to establish a highway therein described.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. That a public highway in the town of Medina, Dane county, "commencing at the so called 'Sun Prairie road,' on the section line between section 14 and 15, then running south on the section line, between sections 14 and 15, and 22 and 23, and 26 and 27 ; one hundred and eight rods and 85 links, south to the quarter post on the east line of section 27, south 32 degrees, west 72 links, thence 56 degrees 30 minutes west 12 chains, and thence in south-westerly course to the township line upon the survey made on the 23d of March, A. D. 1850," be [and] the same is hereby established on said survey at the width of three rods, the centre line of said highway remaining as heretofore established ; the same shall be so recorded in the office of the Town Clerk of said town of Medina.

Highway in the town of Medina established.

§ 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 275.

AN ACT authorizing the Secretary of State to audit certain accounts.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized to audit the accounts of the Wisconsin State Telegraph Company, for daily reports of the stock market in New York, on the certificate of the Bank Comptroller that such reports have been furnished to his department, at the price agreed upon between the Comptroller and the said Company, and the said accounts when so audited shall be paid from the State Treasury.

§ 2. There is hereby appropriated a sufficient amount of money to pay the account mentioned in the preceding section.
