CHAPTER 373.

[Published May 1, 1860.]

AN ACT to authorize commissioners to vacate a certain territorial road in the county of Waukesha.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Andrew Atkin, M. Cellars, and William Werden, are hereby appointed commissioners to vacate such part of the territorial road herein described: "commencing at the east bank of Fox river, on the line between sections four and nine, town six north, of range nineteen east; thence running east on section line between sections four and nine to section stake; thence east on section line between sections three and ten, eighty-five rods, and to the east line of lands owned by the State as a site for the State Reformed [Reform] School.

Vacation to be recorded.

SEC. 2. The said commissioners shall make return of their acts to the town clerk of said town, who shall record the same, and when so recorded, said road shall be and remain, to all intents and purposes, vacated.

SEC. 3. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
