

CHAPTER 4.

[Published January 25, 1860.]

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Samuel Lattimore, as Justice of the Peace in the county of Dane.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Legalizing the official acts of Samuel Lattimore, J. P., Dane county.

SECTION 1. That all the official acts and duties performed by Samuel Lattimore, as justice of the peace in the town of Vermont, in the county of Dane, in this State, prior to the passage of this act, so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this State, are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid for all purposes, as though the said Samuel Lattimore had caused his official bond or bonds, and oath or oaths, to be made and filed in conformity with the statutes of this State.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 5.

AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Isaac C. Steele, as justice of the peace in the county of Dane.

The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

Legalizing the official acts of Isaac C. Steele, Justice of the Peace, Dane county.

SECTION 1. That all the official acts and duties performed by Isaac C. Steele, as justice of the peace, in the town of Vermont, in the county of Dane, in this State, prior to the passage of this act, so far as the same are consistent with the general laws of this State, are hereby legalized, and declared to be as valid, for all purposes, as though the said Isaac C. Steele had caused his official bond or bonds, and oath or oaths, to be made and filed, in conformity with the statutes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
