

## CHAPTER 142.

[Published April 3, 1861.]

AN ACT declaring certain portions of the Sheboygan and Fond du Lac Plank Road a Public Highway.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The line of road of the Sheboygan and Fond du Lac plank road company, including their road bed so far as the same lays within the towns of Forest, Empire and Taycheeda, to the village of Taycheeda, to where the same intersects the Green Bay road, in the county of Fond du Lac, having been abandoned by said company, is hereby declared and established as a public highway, and subject to the control and management of the supervisors of the above named towns respectively in which said road is situated, like other highways. <sup>What portion so declared.</sup>

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 143.

[Published April 2, 1861.]

AN ACT to authorize the State Prison Commissioner to settle with the United States for the support of United States convicts, and to require him to report annually to the Governor respecting such convicts.

*The People of the State of Wisconsin, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the state prison commissioner, once every six months, to make out and present for settlement to the proper auditing officer of the United States for this state, a certified account of the amount which shall then be due and unsettled for the support and maintenance of United States convicts in the state prison of this state. <sup>Semi-annual accounts.</sup>
