

CHAPTER 212.

[*Published April 8, 1862.*]

AN ACT to provid for the apportionment of certain school moneys to the city of Racine.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The city clerk of the city of Racine is hereby directed forthwith to make out and transmit to the state superintendent of public instruction, certified copies of all resolutions and proceedings of the city council of said city, passed or had during the year 1861, relating to the raising of any money for school purposes, and to report the amount ordered to be raised for said year, for such purposes, in said city.

Statement of amount raised for school purposes in Racine.

SECTION 2. If it shall appear from said report, that a sufficient tax has been raised by the city council of said city, for the support of common schools therein, in said year, to entitle said city to a portion of the state school fund, it shall be and is hereby made the duty of said state superintendent, within the time now provided by law for the distribution of the income of the school fund among the several counties in this state, for the year 1861, or as soon thereafter as practicable, to apportion to said city the proportion of school money for said year, to which it may be entitled, and to certify such apportionment to the state treasurer. Said superintendent shall thereupon give notice of such apportionment to the city clerk of said city, stating the amount apportioned to said city, and the time when the same will be payable.

When state superintendent may apportion school money in said city.

SECTION 3. The treasurer of said city shall apply for and receive from the state treasurer, the school moneys apportioned to said city for said year, as soon as the same shall become payable.

Application therefor.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
