

CHAPTER '332.

[Published June 5, 1862.]

AN ACT relating to the redemption of lands which were sold for unpaid taxes levied in the year 1858.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The time for the redemption of lands sold at any time in the year 1859, for the unpaid taxes levied in the year 1858, is hereby extended to the first day of December next. Time extended to Dec. 1.

SECTION 2. If the clerk of the county board of supervisors of any county has caused to be published, in the manner required by existing laws, a list of unredeemed lands which were sold in the year 1859, no further publication shall be necessary in consequence of the preceding section; and in all cases where any such clerk has not caused to be published as provided by law, any list of unredeemed lands sold at any time in said year 1859, for taxes of the preceding year, such clerk shall cause such list to be published for twelve successive weeks prior to the first day of November next, with a notice of the time of redemption, which list and notice shall be published in the newspaper in which such lists and notices are now required to be published. Publication of list.

SECTION 3. This act shall be published and take effect immediately; and the secretary of state shall forthwith transmit printed copies thereof to the several clerks of the county boards of supervisors. Act to be published and copies sent to clerks.
