

CHAPTER 64.

[Published March 5, 1862.]

AN ACT to amend section 8 of an act entitled “an act to amend chapter 175 of the private and local statutes of the state of Wisconsin, entitled “an act to amend an act to incorporate the city of Fond du Lac, approved March 19th, 1852,” approved February 24th, 1855.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section eight of an act entitled “an act Annual election. to amend chapter 175 of the private and local statutes of the state of Wisconsin, entitled ‘an act to amend an act to incorporate the city of Fond du Lac, approved March 19th, 1852,’ approved February 24th, 1855,” is hereby amended so as to read as follows: “The annual charter election of the city of Fond du Lac, shall be held on the first Tuesday of April, in each year.”

SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts conflicting Repeal. with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 67.

AN ACT to allow the towns in Waukesha county to appropriate their license money.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. All moneys derived from licenses granted in the county of Waukesha, under the provisions of chapter thirty-five of the revised statutes of this state, shall be paid into the treasuries of the several towns of said county of Waukesha, where such licenses are granted, and shall be appropriated and paid out as directed by the proper town board of supervisors. To be paid into town treasuries—how appropriated.
