

## CHAPTER 100.

[Published March 5, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend chapter seventy-three of the private and local laws of 1863, entitled "an act to declare Big Plover river a navigable stream."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter seventy-three of <sup>Amendment.</sup> the private and local laws of 1863, is so amended, as to read as follows: "Big Plover river, in the counties of Portage and Marathon, from the mouth of said river up to the northern boundary line of township number twenty-eight, in range number ten, (*be and the same*) is hereby declared a navigable stream."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

Approved March 2, 1864.

## CHAPTER 101.

[Published March 5, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and nine of the private and local [general] laws of 1863, entitled "an act to incorporate the Milwaukee, Winnebago and St. Paul railroad company."

## CHAPTER 102.

[Published March 4, 1864.]

AN ACT authorizing the assessor of the town of Clinton, in Rock county, to amend the assessment roll for the year 1863, and directing the town clerk of said town to compute the tax thereon, and make his warrant upon the town treasurer for the collection of the same.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. The assessor of the town of Clinton, in the county of Rock, Wisconsin, is hereby authorized to <sup>Correction of tax</sup> <sub>law.</sub>

make out and deliver to the town clerk of said town, a true list of all personal property in said town that was listed and not entered upon the assessment roll of said town, for the year 1863.

Computation of taxes.

SECTION 2. The town clerk of said town shall, upon the receipt of such list, compute the tax or taxes in the aggregate upon such personal property, the same as was computed on other personal property in said town for the said year 1863, and when so computed, the said town clerk shall deliver the same to the town treasurer of said town, with a warrant attached, directing said treasurer to collect the said tax or taxes on or before the first day of April next.

Disbursement of taxes.

SECTION 3. The tax or taxes, when so collected, shall be disbursed by the town board of supervisors of said town as they may deem best for the benefit of said town.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 103.

[Published March 5, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter two hundred and seventy-eight of the general laws of 1863, entitled "an act to vacate the village plat of Pittsburg, located on the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of fractional section thirty-six, in town nine, range two west, and to provide for the sale of the same."

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Plat vacated.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and seventy-eight of the general laws of 1863, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Section 1. The plat of the village of Pittsburg, laid out and platted by the commissioners of school and university lands, in the year 1849, upon lot three, or the east half of the southwest quarter of fractional section number thirty-six, town nine, of range two west, (*be and the same*) is hereby vacated."
