CHAPTER 226.

[Published April 11, 1864.]

AN ACT to authorize the improvement of the Menominee river, in the city of Milwaukee.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :*

SECTION 1. The owners of land situated on the opposite sides of the Menominee river, in the city of Milwaukee, between Union street, in the fifth ward, and the east line of section thirty-one in the eighth ward, are hereby authorized and empowered, within the limits of such land so owned by them, to straighten and widen the channel thereof: *provided*, that the navigation of no part of said river shall be interrupted thereby, to the damage of any person, without compensation; and *provided, further*, that the dock lines of the river when permanently established, shall conform to the ordinances of said city, and such portion of said river shall be subject to the control of said city, in like manner as the improved portions of the Menominee and Milwaukee rivers.

River may be straightened and channel widened.

Proviso.

SECTION 2. Whenever the owners of any portion of the land lying on opposite sides of said river and of the proposed improvement, shall determine to straighten and widen said river, they shall make a plan or map of such improvement, by them duly signed and acknowledged, showing the lines and boundaries thereof, and shall file the same with the clerk of the common council of said city, which map, unless disapproved by the

common council, shall operate as a dedication of the land and water therein laid out for a river to the public as a navigable river.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 228.

[Published April 5, 1864.]

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter 390 of the general laws of 1862, relating to the superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

Stationery to be purchased by superintendent of public property.

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 390 of the general laws of 1862, is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Section 1. Chapter 27 of the revised statutes, entitled 'of the state superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery for the use of the state,' is hereby amended, by striking out the whole of section five of said chapter, and inserting the following in lieu thereof: 'The superintendent of public property is hereby constituted the agent of the state to purchase all stationery for the use of the state, at a compensation not exceeding five hundred dollars per annum, which agent shall let the contract every year for furnishing the said stationery to

Compensation.
