The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Them of office of Shotion 1. Section one of chapter sixty of the gencemby judge. eral laws of eighteen hundred fifty-nine, (1859,) is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Section 1. County judges now in office, shall continue in office until the expiration of the term for which they were elected, respectively; and each and every county judge hereafter elected shall hold and continue in office for and during the term of four years from and after the first day of January next after his election, and until his successor is elected and qualified: provided, that In one of the when a vacancy in such office shall be filled by an election, the person elected shall hold during the unexpired term only; and when such vacancy shall be filled by an appointment, the person appointed shall hold until his successor is elected and qualified, in accordance with the provisions of section ninety-four (94) of chapter seven (7) of the revised statutes."
