

CHAPTER 327.

[Published April 21, 1864.]

AN ACT to legalize the issuing of town bonds in the town of Winneconne, Winnebago county, to volunteers into the service of the United States.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The town bonds of the town of Winneconne, in Winnebago county, issued by the supervisors of said town, in pursuance of a special town meeting held in said town of Winneconne, on the 12th day of February, A. D. 1864, for the purpose of raising money and paying bounties to volunteers into the military service of the United States, are hereby legalized and declared to be valid against said town of Winneconne, to all intents and purposes. Issue of bonds legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 328.

[Published April 21, 1864.]

AN ACT to legalize the issuing of town orders in the town of Menasha, Winnebago county, to volunteers in the military service of the United States.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The town orders of the town of Menasha, in Winnebago county, issued by the supervisors of said town, for the purpose of raising and paying bounty to volunteers in the military service of the United States, are hereby legalized and declared to be valid against said town of Menasha, to all intents and purposes. Issue of town orders legalized.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
