town board of said town, conditioned to faithfully per-

form all the duties required by this act.

Bucron 8. The money received and paid into the Application of town treasury of said town, under and by virtue of this act, shall be exclusively applied to the payment of bounties to volunteers mustered into the military service of this state, and credited to said town of Addison, at a rate not exceeding two hundred [dollars] for each volunteer, and for the payment of expenses incident and necessary to carry this act into effect.

Section 6. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 86.

[Published February 27, 1864.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Pertage to levy and collect a tax to pay bounties to volunteers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Port-Authority to age are hereby authorized to raise and appropriate money ment of bounties as a bounty for volunteers, and to levy a tax upon all the to volunteers. taxable property in said city to pay the same, which tax shall be assessed and collected in the same manner as other city taxes; but no money shall be so raised or appropriated unless the proposal to raise the same shall first be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said city, and be approved by them. Before the coun- question first to cil shall raise and appropriate such money and levy vote. such tax, they shall specify the amount to be raised and the object thereof, and shall cause notice of the time and place of voting thereon to be posted in three of the most public places in said city, not less than five nor more than fifteen days prior to such election.

SECTION 2. The common council may direct that one One pell only may be held. poll be held for the entire city, and may appoint the requisite number of officers, whose duty it shall be to

take such vote and make the return of the same to the council.

Not in conflict.

Section 8. No provision or provisions of the charter of said city shall be held as conflicting with this act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 87.

[Published February 27, 1864.]

AN ACT to extend the time for the collection of taxes in the town of Beloit, Bock county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Extended to March 25. SECTION 1. The time for the collection of taxes in the town of Beloit, in the county of Rock, is hereby extended until the twenty-fifth day of March, 1864: provided, that this act shall not be so construed as to extend the time for the payment of state taxes.

Collection and return of taxes,

SECTION 2. The treasurer of said town shall have the same power and authority to collect the taxes contained in said town tax roll after as before such extension of time for the collection of said taxes, and the return of the town treasurer to the county treasurer, within the time limited for the collection of taxes by this act, shall be as valid as if made pursuant to the direction of the original warrant.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
