## CHAPTER 92.

[Published March 4, 1864.]

AN ACT to legalize the proceedings of the common council of the city of Janesville, and to authorize said city to levy a tax to pay orders issued in payment of bounties to volunteers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Issue of orders, &c. legalized.

SECTION 1. All the acts and proceedings of the common council of the city of Janesville, done and had at any time after the 23d day of December, A. D. 1863, either in issuing or authorizing to be issued orders on the treasurer of said city, in payment of bounties to volunteers, authorized and directed to be paid by a vote of the electors of said city, given at a meeting of such electors, called for that purpose, and held in said city on the 23d day of December, A. D. 1868, are hereby legalized and declared to be in all things valid; and all the aforesaid acts and proceedings of said common council, in issuing or authorizing to be issued orders on said treasurer for the payment of interest on the first named orders, for the time the same, respectively, have to run, are also hereby legalized and declared to be in all things valid and binding.

Tax to pay or-

SECTION 2. The said common council are hereby empowered and directed to levy and collect, in the same manner and at the same time as other taxes for city purposes are levied and collected, a tax on the taxable property of said city, sufficient to pay the aforesaid orders, as well as said orders for interest as otherwise, at the time the same, respectively, become due and payable, according to the terms thereof.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
