## CHAPTER 180.

[Published March 28, 1865.]

AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, entitled "of the state superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery for the use of the state."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

State historical nonety envitled to stationery. SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes, entitled "of the state superintendent of public property, and the purchase and distribution of stationery for the use of the state," is hereby amended, by inserting after "to the clerk of the supreme court, for the supreme court room," in said ninth section, the words, "to the secretary of the state historical society, for the state historical society room and correspondence."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

## CHAPTER 131.

[Published March 28, 1865.]

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the general laws of 1864, relating to the county court of Fond du Lac county, Wisconsin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Jurisdiction of tounty overt abolished.

SECTION 1. Chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127) of the general laws of 1864, relating to the county court of Fond du Lac county, is hereby repealed.

Puits pending to be disposed of in strents court.

SECTION 2. All suits and proceedings now pending in said county court, under and by virtue of the provisions of chapter one hundred and twenty-seven (127,) general laws 1864, are hereby transferred to the circuit court of Fond du Lac county, and the same shall be
