

CHAPTER 25.

[Published February 16, 1865.]

AN ACT to amend chapter 16 of the general laws of 1863, entitled "an act to authorize the entry of judgments in actions brought against persons charged as jointly liable."

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter 16 of the general laws of 1863, entitled "an act to authorize the entry of judgments in actions brought against persons charged as jointly liable," is hereby amended, so as to read as follows: "Section 1. Whenever it shall appear on the trial of an action on contract against several defendants sought to be charged as jointly liable, that such contract was made by either or any of such defendants, or that either or any of such defendants were liable on such contracts at the time of the commencement of such action, the court may render judgment against such of the defendants as are proved on such trial to be liable upon such contract to the plaintiff in such action."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT to authorize and enable Thomas B. Burnett, a minor, to convey and to contract for the conveyance of his real estate.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Thomas B. Burnett, of Prairie du Chien, in this state, a minor, of the age of about twenty years, is hereby authorized and empowered to grant, convey, contract for the conveyance of or mortgage any or all of the real estate of which he is seized, or in which he may have any interest, either in this or any other state,
