

CHAPTER 427.

[Published May 27, 1865.]

AN ACT to vacate a certain alley in the city of Beaver Dam.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The alley running through the center ^{Vacated.} of block number seven (7) of Rose's addition to Beaver Dam, (in the fourth ward of the city of Beaver Dam, Dodge county, Wisconsin,) is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 428.

AN ACT to vacate a cemetery in the town of Bangor, La Crosse county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. The cemetery laid out and platted by ^{Vacated.} John Wheldon, on the southeast quarter of the north-east quarter of section No. (5) five, township No. (16) sixteen, of range No. (5) five west, in the town of Bangor, La Crosse county, and recorded in book of plats on page 56, in the office of register of deeds for said county, is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
