The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The superintendent of public instruc- school moneyeto tion is hereby authorized and directed to apportion to towns of Gen see the towns of Genesee and Mukwonago, in the county and Mukwonage. of Waukesha, for the present year, the full amount of school moneys to which said towns would have been entitled, if joint school district number eight, of said towns, had maintained a school during the year 1864, the number of months required by law; and the town To be apportion-clerks of the said towns are hereby directed to apport the trick No. 8. tion to said joint district number eight, its full share of all school moneys coming into the hands of the town treasurers the present year, the same as if the annual report of said district for 1864, had shown that a three months' school had been maintained therein during the year ending at the date of said report.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect from and after
