CHAPTER 5.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Lebanon, in Dodge county, to collect a tax to pay bounties to volunteers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Tax may be sol-

SECTION 1. The town officers of the town of Lebanon, in Dodge county, are hereby authorized to levy and collect upon the last assessment roll of said town, the amount of tax voted by the electors of said town, at a town meeting held in said town on the 9th day of January, 1865.

When to be collected.

Limit to boun-.

SECTION 2. Said tax shall be collected as soon as practicable, in the manner now provided by law: provided, it shall be so collected before the first Monday in March; and provided, the amount so raised shall not exceed the sum of two hundred dollars to be paid to each volunteer.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Milwaukee to erect a school house in the third ward of said city.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Authority to erect school house.

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of Milwaukee are hereby authorized to cause to be erected a new school house in the third ward of said city, upon the premises now occupied by the present school house, apon plans and specifications to be procured to be made by the comptroller of said city; such building to be L'mit to expense erected at an expense not exceeding \$20,000, and the contract for the erection thereof to be let to the lowest bidder, as other work is contracted to be done for said city, according to law.

SECTION 2. The common council of said city are Levy and colleshereby authorized to assess, levy and collect the amount for. to be expended in the erection of said new school house, not exceeding said sum of \$20,000, in the same manner as other taxes are levied and collected in said city, and in addition to the amount authorized by law to be raised by taxation for general city purposes, and to include said amount in the tax lists of the year 1865.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in full force after its passage and publication.

AN ACT to incorporate the village of Princeton.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows :

SECTION 1. All that district of country situate in Boundardes the county of Green Lake, and embraced in the following boundaries, to wit: Beginning at the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section number eighteen (18,) in township number sixteen (16) north, of range number twelve (12) east, and running thence west to the line between ranges eleven (11) and twelve (12;) thence north on said range line to the northeast corner of section number twenty-four (24,) in township number sixteen (16) north, of range number eleven (11) east; thence west to the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of said section twenty-four; thence south to the southwest corner of the northeast quarter
